

Warrant Information

Court Issued Warrants

The Court may issue a warrant when:

- You fail to appear.
- You fail to comply with an Order of the Court.
- You do not complete a payment plan or fail to make a payment as promised.

Failure to Appear

If you fail to appear on or before the arraignment date at the bottom of your citation, a violation of Failure to Appear may be filed against you. In addition, the court may:

1. Issue a warrant for your arrest.
2. Add a \$50 warrant charge per violation.
3. Add a \$30 OMNI DL charge per violation.

Failure to meet an Order of the Court

If you have appeared before the judge and have agreed to a payment plan, driving safety course, or deferred, you must complete these orders as specified or a warrant may be issued for your arrest.

Resolving a Warrant

Your warrant may be canceled by pleading “No Contest” or “Guilty” to the violation(s) and making payment for the fine(s). In person: Payment must be in the form of cash, check, or money order. Your warrant will remain outstanding until your payment is received.
