WOW! Have you noticed how much brighter the community is after dark? Thanks to Buddy Moore, our Public Works Director, and Terri White, our City Secretary/Treasurer, this was accomplished. Buddy listed the number of each light fixture that was not burning, and Terri transmitted them via computer to Center Point Energy and they were repaired within the week. Thank you for making our streets and homes safer after dark. Buddy has also gotten our water plant back in compliance with the new signage installed. We thank him also for agreeing to be our Floodplain Administrator. Buddy is a Brazoria County Drainage Commissioner, and has the necessary credentials to perform this job.

Our Fire Chief, Rocky Hicks and Police Chief, Randy Langston spoke to the Council about the purchase of two mobile radio units at a onetime cost of \$1,524.56, that will allow the police department to have radio communication with the fire department and Danbury EMS, allowing our Police personal to arrive at the scene of a fire, traffic accident, or medical emergency, and relay the situation, also providing traffic control. The council approved this purchase.

Thank you to Mark Roller who has volunteered to be our Emergency Management Coordinator. Mark is a Brazoria County Drainage Commissioner, and has the credentials and training for this position. In the months of June and July, he has attended 55 EMS Education & Training meetings to help him prepare for any emergency our community might encounter. If you would like to receive emails about storms or other emergencies, or need a ride in case of a hurricane, please return the form enclosed in your water bill, or come by the city hall and complete a form. We applaud citizens like Mark who donate their personal time to ensure that our community is protected.

A big thank you to Heath Smith, our Patrol Officer, when the light bar on the patrol car needed repairs estimated to be over \$400.00, he took several old light bars and removed parts and bulbs from them and repaired the bar. Thank you again.

On July 24<sup>th</sup>, the Liverpool Community Response Team held a CERT 100 Disaster Response Drill and certification for the CERT 100 Members, Judy Champagne, Delores Peters, Mariann Stavinoha, Brett Rowley, Derek Shoobridge, Kimberly Miller, Kenneth Miller, Johnny Wolfe, and Mark Roller. We commend these individuals for taking their personal time to learn how to help their families and the community in case of an emergency. Please say thank you to these individuals the next time you see them.
