ORDINANCE NO.: 2012-F

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF LIVERPOOL, TEXAS PROHIBITING PARKING IN NON-DESINTATED AREAS ON CITY PROPERTY, AND THE INFORCEMENT OF ILLEGALLY PARKED AUTOMBILES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVERPOOL, BRAZORA COUNTY TEXAS:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

WHEREAS parking in undesignated area on city property is prohibited and illegal, in an act to keep City grounds clean.

SECTION 2: POHIBITED PARKING AREAS

No automobile, be it car, truck, motorcycle, dirt bike, go-cart, 4-wheeler, commercial automobile, or any other engine powered machine may not park in prohibited areas.

Prohibited areas are as follows:

- Grass around the pavilion
- In the pavilion (on the pavilion slab)

SECTION 3: ENFORCEMENT

Signs shall be posted stating "No parking".

Any automobile, as described in this ordinance that is found to be parked in the prohibited areas shall be towed at the registered owner's expense.

The registered owner of the automobile that is found parked in the prohibited area shall be fined no less than ten dollars (\$10.00) and nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

SECTION 4: SEVERABILTY

Should any section, provision, or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or void by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining parts, and for this purpose said parts are severable. The City Council hereby declares that it would be passed those parts of this ordinance which are valid and omitted any parts which may be unconstitutional at the time of the passage of this ordinance.
