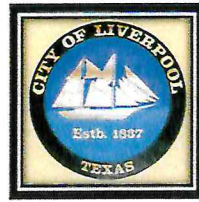

We have finally got the grant completed, and we will have a road construction company, Craig & Heidt, Inc., start the work on Avenue H on April 12, 2021. The primary location of Avenue H that will be under construction is between 8<sup>th</sup> Street and Vesper, which is the worst section of Avenue H. The work should only take about 2 weeks from start to finish. The City is also working on getting more grant money to improve more of our streets around the city.
