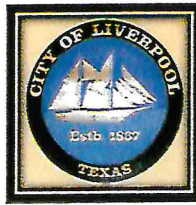

The Mayor and City Council have been putting money aside several years for this project, so no money had to be borrowed. Thank you for planning and spending wisely for our community.
