- Larry Grover requested permission to move out a manufactured home and move in a pre-built 2-bedroom 1000 sq. ft. home with a 2-car garage at 2111 1st Street.
 - Motion was made by Council Member Craig Kartye to allow Mr. Grover to move out the manufactured home and replace it with a pre-built home.

- Dan Tucker requested to move an RV onto his property at 2311 7th Street and to live in the RV until the inside of his home is finished. He is building a new home on the property and the outside construction is done but would like to live on the property while the inside is being finished. He stated that it would be less than 90 days.


