ANNUAL AUDIT: The City of Liverpool had the annual audit performed by Baker, Stogner & Associates, CPA. Jeff Stogner presented the audit at the last City Council meeting and reported that the City is in excellent fiscal condition with no outstanding debt obligations. The city has had an excellent report on the audit for several years.

CITY COUNCIL NEWS: The City Council voted to lower the tax rate to 0.147731 from 0.164649. The City Council also approved the city budget for the upcoming year. The new budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$1046 or 2.55%, and of the amount \$1046 is tax revenue to be raised from NEW property added to the tax roll this year. We are very grateful to City Council and staff for doing such a great job holding down expenses for our city.

MOVIE NIGHT: Our next free movie night will be October 2, 2021. We will be showing "*Nightmare Before Christmas*". Wear your Halloween costume and be prepared to be SCARED.
