If there is not a Liverpool Officer on duty, a Brazoria County Sheriff's Officer will be dispatched. The Liverpool Post Office number is 281-581-2270. City Council meetings are open to the public and are the 1st Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM at City Hall. You may pay your water bill online at www.cityofliverpooltexas.com. There is a link on the home page. We do not have auto draft; however, you may pay extra on your bill and have a credit on your account. If you pay extra, you still get a water statement showing how much credit you have left each month. Please note that if paying online or on the phone with a credit card, there is a convenience fee of \$3.00 per \$100.00.
