RV ORDINANCE: On October 3, 2023, City Council passed a new RV ordinance, and will start being enforced in November. The ordinance states that it is still unlawful for anyone to live in an RV within the city limits of Liverpool. It shall also be unlawful to rent out an RV that is not in an RV park. There is a new provision that states *"The prohibition against residing in a recreational vehicle shall not apply to individuals that currently reside in a recreational vehicle on the date of this passage of this ordinance and such resident shall be 'grandfathered'."* It also states that, *"Any person that resides in a recreational vehicle under the grant of a special variance shall NOT be 'grandfathered.'"* Per the ordinance, any "Grandfathered" RV MUST come to City Hall and fill out a registration form.
