Mayor's Message February 2025

EZEE FIBER: You may have noticed all the fiber optic lines that are being put in around town. The Company putting in the lines is EZEE Fiber, they are an internet company that will be providing internet to the area. They will be working in the area for a few more weeks.

WATER: On January 3, 2025, a third-party company putting in fiber optic lines for EZEE Fiber hit a water main line on the corner of 2nd Street and Avenue F. The line had a whole bored completely through the line, on both sides of the 6” water main pipe. The Water department tried to turn off just the water in that area, however, the turn off valves did not work when they were turned to turn off the water. With the size of leak, the water plant lost pressure, and the whole city was without water. We are currently working on maintaining all the turn off valves to make sure that they are working properly.

FOOD PANTRY: The food pantry continues to provide food to the residents in our community that need a little help. The food pantry takes donations all year around. If you want to donate to the pantry, you may drop the donations off at City Hall during regular business hours; or in the box located at the Post Office. The food pantry is always needing things like, soups, chili, cereal, tuna, peanut butter, jelly, instant potatoes, frozen dinners, anything that is quick and easy to make. The food pantry asks that you NOT donate bulk bags of things, like rice, and beans. *“Charity isn’t about pity; it is about love.” – Mother Teresa*

SNOW: We hope that everyone came out ok during the Snow on January 21, 2025. It was a beautiful sight to see. There were no major problems reported to the city regarding broken water pipes.
