PERSONAL MESSAGE FROM MAYOR BOGUE: On May 3, 2025, Liverpool will be having a City Election. The mayor's position and two City Council positions are up for re-election. I have been involved with the City since 2011, starting on City Council, then to Mayor Pro Tem and becoming Mayor in April of 2022 with the untimely passing of Mayor Strickland. ELECTION: For the first time in 14 years, the City of Liverpool will be having an election for the mayor, and 2 City Council positions. Early voting begins April 22, 2025, to April 29, 2025. Election day is May 3, 2025. The City of Liverpool City Hall will be a voting place on May 3, 2025, only. If you want to early vote, you will have to go to one of the polling places, a list of dates, places and times is posted on the City of Liverpool's website, on the bulletin board at City Hall, and on Brazoria Counties website as well. Please exercise your right to vote in this election, your vote matters.
